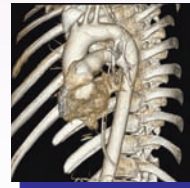
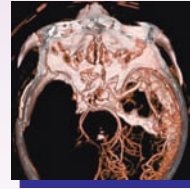
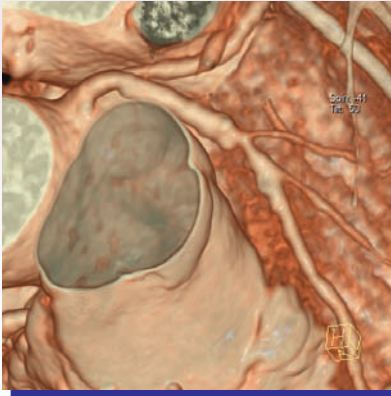
At the conclusion of the course, attendees should be able to:
